Mission:

The Lineworker Pre-Apprenticeship is a program to assist emerging youth in their efforts to prepare for a career as an Electric Lineworker.

Participant Criteria:

- Must be a high school senior during the 2022-2023 school year
- Must be 18 by June 1, 2023 to participate in a summer work opportunity
- Must attend high school in Johnston County (public, charter, private, or homeschool)
- Must participate in all sessions if selected
- Must be able to participate in two half-day job shadow days during the program
- Must submit application to school Career Development Coordinator (CDC) by September 23, 2022

COVID-19 Precautions and Requirements*
